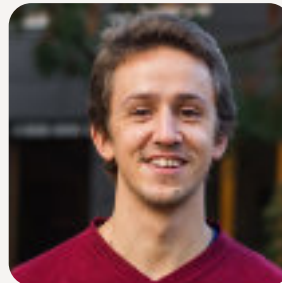
Manouchehr Shamsrizi, Founder of RetroBrain R&D

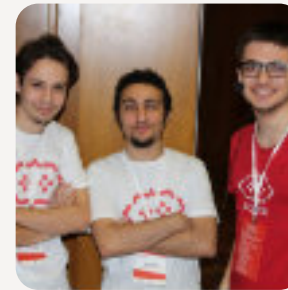
